### Event 2 : Provide medicine to Police Staff for leptospirosis

Date : 6/07/19



Leptospirosis is an infectious disease that can occur in humans and animals worldwide. Symptoms and signs of leptospirosis are highly variable and range from no symptoms to nonspecific symptoms including high fever, chills, headache, and abdominal symptoms to Weil's disease with organ dysfunction.

Vaccines are available for humans and animals in some countries. There is no vaccine available commercially for humans in the U.S. Available vaccines are limited because they usually only protect well against a single serovar. Doxycycline (Vibramycin, Oracea, Adoxa, Atridox) has been used as a short-term preventive treatment to protect some humans from leptospirosis. So, we as an institution are happy and proud to collaborate in this for this wonderful initiative.

Dr.Dhruv Mamtora**

**Date : 11/07/19**



Since the end of the 20th century, precautions of hospital infection have been re-evaluated with rationalization. Evidence-based precautions are proposed to be discussed. Problems of hospital infection in the early 21st century are highlighted as follows: (1) infections in compromised patients; (2) emergence of resistant bacteria; (3) terminal infection; (4) bloodborne virus infection; (5) neonatal infections; (6) emerging and re-emerging diseases. In the near future, it will be possible to lower the hospital infection rate by practising universal precaution and the development of low invasive surgeries. These and more important pointers were explained to our Staff by Dr. Dhruv Mamtora (Consultant - Infection control).
